Mission Statement

HIGH DESERT PREGNANCY CLINIC is a Christian organization dedicated to the sanctity of human life. We provide support and education to those facing situations related to abortion, sexual health and family life from a Biblical perspective. We uphold human life from conception to natural death and encourage a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.

Statement of Faith

1. We believe the Bible to be the inspired, the only infallible, authoritative Word of God.
2. We believe that there is one God, eternally existent in three persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.
3. We believe in the deity of our Lord Jesus Christ, in His virgin birth, in His sinless life, in His vicarious and atoning death through His shed blood, in His bodily resurrection, in His ascension to the right hand of the Father, and in His personal return in power and glory.
4. We believe that for the salvation of lost and sinful man, regeneration by the Holy Spirit is absolutely essential, and that this salvation is received through faith in Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord and not as a result of good works.
5. We believe in the present ministry of the Holy Spirit by whose indwelling the Christian is enabled to live a godly life and to perform good works.
6. We believe in the resurrection of both the saved and the lost; they that are saved unto the resurrection of life and they that are lost unto the resurrection of damnation.
7. We believe in the spiritual unity of believers in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Statement of Principle

1. HDPC, is an outreach ministry of Jesus Christ through His church. Therefore, HDPC, embodied in its volunteers, is committed to presenting the gospel of our Lord to those experiencing unplanned pregnancies - both in word and in deed. Commensurate with this purpose, those who labor as HDPC Board members, staff, and volunteers, are expected to know Jesus Christ as their Savior and Lord.
 2. HDPC is committed to providing its clients with accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
 3. HDPC is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust and providing promised information and services. HDPC denounces any form of deception in its corporate advertising or individual conversations with its clients.
 4. All ministries of HDPC are committed to assisting women to carry their pregnancies to term by providing emotional support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
 5. HDPC does not discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age, or marital status of its clients.
 6. HDPC does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion or abortifacients.
 7. HDPC offers most services free of charge except as clearly disclosed in advance to potential clients. For example, lab fees may be incurred through third party laboratories used by Life Services. Additionally, a small fee for residential care in Life Services' Maternity Home is required.
 8. HDPC is committed to creating an awareness within the local community of the needs of pregnant women and of the fact that abortions only compound human need rather than resolve it.
 9. HDPC does not recommend, provide, or refer single women for contraceptives. All clients, single or married, are encouraged toward sexual integrity.
 10. HDPC recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion, but is not biased toward adoption when compared to other life-saving alternatives. HDPC is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources. HDPC /Crisis Pregnancy Centers receives no payment of any kind from these agencies, does not enter in contractual relationships with them, and does not share combined office space. Adoption agencies are not established under the auspices of HDPC. HDPC neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions. Clients who are interested in private adoptions are referred to independent adoption attorneys for assistance.
- Qualified applicants receive consideration on the basis of qualifications for the position without regard to race, color, sex, age, national origin, marital status, or handicap except as provided by law. As a religious organization, HIGH DESERT PREGNANCY CLINIC is permitted by law, and reserves the right to prefer employees on the basis of religion.*
